## ABOUT THE SPEAKERS:



**Dave Rohrer** is Fairfax County's deputy executive for public safety programs. He oversees multiple agencies including the Police Department, Fire and Rescue Department, Department of Public Safety Communications and Office of Emergency Management. Prior to his current role, he was with the Fairfax County Police Department for 32 years, eight of them as chief. Chief Rohrer has served two terms as chairman of the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments Police Chiefs' Committee and is a member of many related organizations including the International Association of Chiefs of Police, the Major Cities Chiefs' Association, the Police Executive Research Forum and Virginia Association of Chiefs of Police.



**Keith Stefanelli** is senior director, situational awareness and decision support for the American Red Cross. A homeland security and emergency management professional with a unique blend of strategic planning, policy analysis and all-hazards response and recovery experience, he joined the Red Cross in 2013 after a stint with ICF International. Mr. Stefanelli holds a master's degree in public policy from George Washington University and a bachelor's degree from Boston College.



**Sheena Gill** (*emcee*) is general counsel and vice president of contracts for C2 Technologies, Inc. In addition to contracts, Ms. Gill has experience in corporate law, litigation, and management and business development. Mr. McCane came to FEMA after a 20-year career at the IRS, where he served as director for the Office of Information Technology Acquisitions, an organization that obligated \$1.6 billion and awarded more than 10,000 actions annually. He received his MBA and BA from Bowie State University.



**John Morrison** serves as a planning section chief within the Urban Search and Rescue team, Virginia Task Force 1. The planning section is responsible for situational awareness, information technology, mapping, finance and documentation while the team is deployed. He has been a member of the team since 2003. He also serves as fire chief for the Vienna, Virginia, Volunteer Fire Department and is a senior lead technologist at Booz Allen Hamilton.



**Danny Moshe** is president and CEO of Reston-based GreenVision Systems, Inc. and CEO and co-founder of GreenVision Systems Ltd. of Israel. He is a member of the Environmental Protection Air and Waste Management Association and previously served as program manager for Elisa Ltd. in Israel. Mr. Moshe holds multiple degrees, including an MBA from Tel Aviv University, and is experienced in marketing, research and development, project management and management of technology companies.
